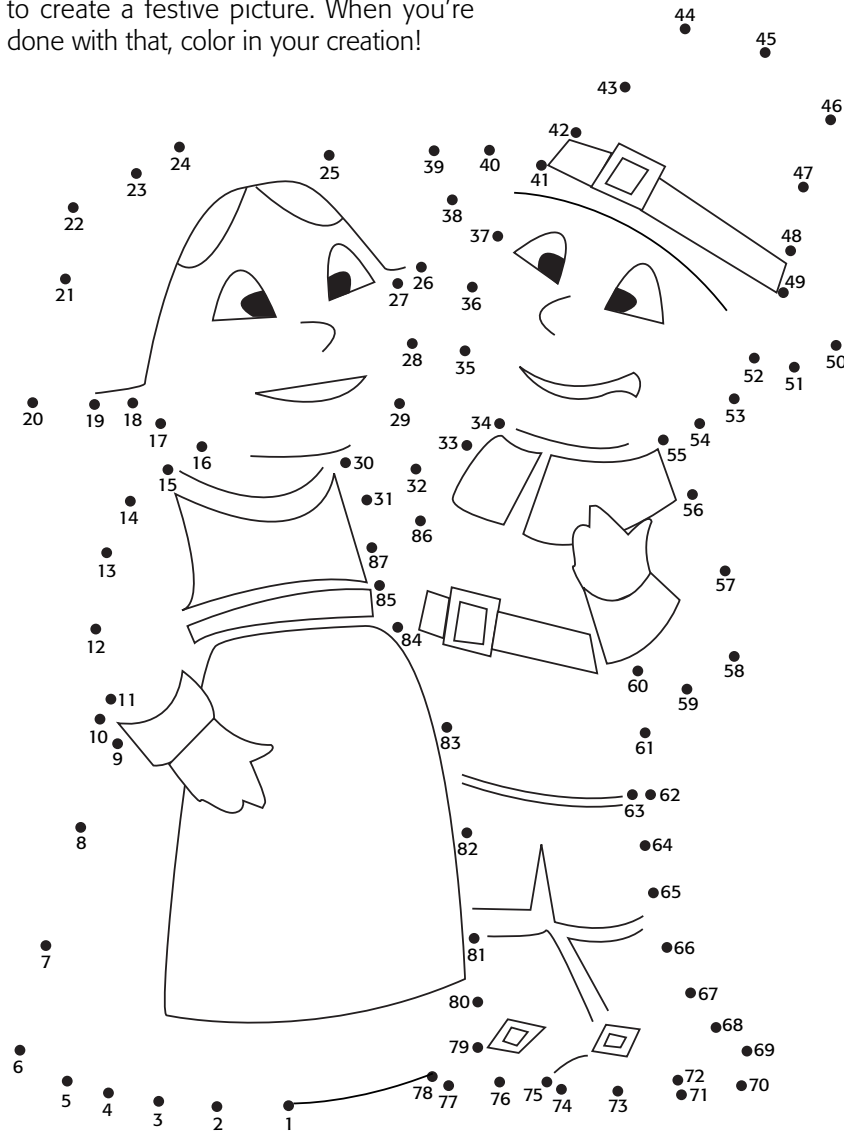




Connect-the-Dots

Follow the numbers and connect-the-dots to create a festive picture. When you're done with that, color in your creation!



Pinecone Turkey

MATERIALS:

- Large pinecone
- Pom-pom (brown or black)
- Felt (yellow and red)
- Plastic eyes
- Glue
- Pipe cleaners (assorted colors)
- Feathers (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Using the red and yellow felt cut out a beak (yellow) and wattle (red). Glue the plastic eyes and felt pieces to the pom-pom.
2. Glue the pom-pom head to the end of the pinecone.
3. Use a pipe cleaner to create 3-toed feet by wrapping it around the middle of the pinecone and securing it with twists on the bottom, and then create toes on either end of the pipe cleaner.
4. Use 3 or 4 pipe cleaners to create the turkey's tail by wrapping the pipe cleaners, one-by-one, around the end of the pinecone, starting at the bottom, then twist together and loop the ends to form a feather-like effect. –OR– Glue feathers to the end of the pinecone for a more realistic effect.
